December 8th, 2018 - Logic from the Ancient Greek $\lambda\omicron\gamma\iota\kappa\acute{\alpha}$ translit *logiká*,— originally meaning the word or what is spoken but coming to mean thought or reason is a subject concerned with the most general laws of truth and is now generally held to consist of the systematic study of the form of valid inference A valid inference is one where there is a specific relation of logical support

December 9th, 2018 - Formal logic The predicate calculus Propositions may also be built up not out of other propositions but out of elements that are not themselves propositions The simplest kind to be considered here are propositions in which a certain object or individual in a wide sense is said to possess a certain property or characteristic e g "Socrates is wise" and "The number 7 is prime"

December 10th, 2018 - History of logic Logic since 1900 The early development of logic after 1900 was based on the late 19th century work of Gottlob Frege Giuseppe Peano and Georg Cantor among others Different lines of research were unified by a general effort to use symbolic sometimes called mathematical or formal techniques Gradually this research led to profound changes in the very idea of what logic is
